The scholarship is non-renewable.

Eligibility Criteria

- * Erie/Huron, or contiguous counties, Ohio resident
- * Minimum 2.8 grade point average
- * Completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

The application deadline is **5 p.m. Friday, May 5, 2017**. Our scholarship is based on field of study, merit, financial need and community involvement. The decision is final and will be announced in late June. The scholarship will be paid to the school (not to an individual or bookstore) in one installment.
